

**Applicants for the Miss Hibernia Pageant must meet the following requirements:**

1. You must be of Irish Descent.
2. You must be between the ages of 16-22 on March 17, 2023.
3. Open to young women, single and never married.
4. The Official Biographical Form must be completed and submitted with the entry form.
5. Resident of Genesee County or a full-time student at a high school or college in Genesee County.
6. You must be able to attend an interview with the Screening Committee on Sunday, February 26, 2023 from 2:00-4:30PM at Brickstreet of Grand Blanc restaurant.
7. You must be able to attend the pageant contest on March 4th at 4:00PM at Dom Polski Hall located at 3415 N. Linden Rd. (Mt. Morris Twp., west of I-75, south of Pierson Rd.) and, if chosen as Miss Hibernia or a runner-up, you must remain for the St. Patrick's Day Pre-Party fundraiser immediately following when Miss Hibernia and her Court will be introduced to the public.
8. You must be able to participate in St. Patrick Day events in Flint on March 17th.
